SNOWSHOE WEAVING WORKSHOP - GENERAL INFORMATION -

The Green Mountain snowshoe frames are made of ash. The webbing is a tubular nylon that is easy to work with and has a strength of 1400# per strand. Once a coat of polyurethane varnish is applied, the snowshoes take on the warm amber glow and look of traditional rawhide.

At the completion of the workshop, both shoes will be woven and ready to be brought home and varnished. Instructions on how to do so will be provided.

If your body weight plus the weight of any pack you will be carrying is over 200 pounds, instead of weaving a Green Mountain, it is suggested you weave an Ojibwa style snowshoe which offers enough floatation for about 240 pounds. If you have any questions, don't hesitate to call Anne (902–203–7696) to discuss options.

A recommended binding for your traditional snowshoe is the Super A binding. It is easy to slip on and off, requires no adjusting between users with different sized feet, and mitigates lateral movement of the shoe on the foot while in use.
